According to the student's interests

The curriculum includes both a series of mandatory courses, which are intended to lay the foundations or consolidate fundamental notions and concepts, and a series of optional courses, from which students can choose those that best respond to their area of interest, between the Global South and the Global North or between different regions (Central and Eastern Europe, Latin America, Africa, Asia).
